

Performances of Handel's Messiah Parts II & III Good Friday 29 March 2024 Information for Choristers

Performance details

3.00pm-5.00pm – performance of Parts II and III, with an interval.

Venue again is Epping Baptist Church, Cnr Ray & Carlingford Rds, Epping. Parking is available on the street in Ray Rd or at the Coles car park in Rawson St (100 metres from the church, 2hr limit during the day). Alternatively, the church is 5 minutes' walk from Epping Station.

As in prior years, choristers can participate in Good Friday Messiah in two ways.

- 1. Those who feel able to learn only some of the choruses can choose to be part of just the *Full Choir*. OR
- 2. Those who would like to sing all of the choruses are encouraged to be part of the *Core Choir*.

Practice Schedule:

Practices will be held at Epping Baptist Church on the dates below. *Everyone comes to the "Full Choir" rehearsals*. Those who want to sing *all* of the choruses also come to the two "Core choir" rehearsals.


Each chorister will need to have their own score (Prout edition preferred). If you need to purchase one, the cover of the current published version looks like this:

Alternatively you can download a pdf public domain copy from the IMSLP website. Here's how:

- Click on this link: http://imslp.org/wiki/Messiah, HWV 56 (Handel, George Frideric).
- 2. Scroll down the page quite a way to the section headed "Sheet Music"
- 3. Click on the *Vocal Scores* tab at the top of this section
- 4. Scroll down to the *Complete Score, Arranger: Ebenezer Prout, Piano Reduction* version (IMSLP number #162689).
- 5. Click on the down arrow in this section to download. The file is 17mb.

There will also be a limited number of this public domain copy available in printed form (spiral bound, black cardboard cover) for sale at the first couple of rehearsals.

Please ensure that for the performance your score has a black cover of some form on it.





Pre-preparation

If you are not familiar with the choruses, we ask that you begin to familiarise yourself with your part prior to practices commencing. You can find recordings on YouTube and also part rehearsal tracks, for example at the youtube channel Chord Perfect.

Please Register!

It would be a great help if you let us know that you are able to participate. Please give us your details, so we can stay in touch as the time draws closer. This also helps us gain a picture of what the choir will look like. There is no cost to be part of the choir (except your time and your voice!).

The online form will ask you:

- The part you sing (Soprano, Alto, Tenor or Bass). Sopranos if you are able to let us know whether you are 1st or 2nd Soprano, please do. If you do not yet know, that's OK.
- Whether you expect to be in the core choir (singing all the choruses), or singing the main choruses only. You are free change this later if you want to; it just gives us an initial idea.
- Your phone and email contact details.
